

Poster Contest

Rules:

1. Make a poster for your FCCLA chapter. It can be for membership, an event, or explaining a national program. Make it usable and plan to take it home after the conference.
2. On the back of the poster that you will submit for judging, attach the following information (stapled or taped): Level 1 or Level 2. **IF YOUR POSTER IS NOT LABELED, IT WILL BE JUDGED AT LEVEL 2.**
3. The name of your chapter must be on the poster.
4. Judging will be done according to the standards below
5. Middle school and High school will not be judged together.

Goals:

- To Promote FCCLA as a student-run organization
- To Promote National Programs
- To Increase Membership
- To Promote Star and Skill Events

Level:

Level 1= Middle school

Level 2= High school

If you have a combined chapter and you are entering only one poster, you must enter the level of students who created the poster. If two levels worked on the poster, you must enter the highest level.

Rating Criteria:

40 points – Information is clearly visible and accurate.

10 points – Usage of the term FCCLA

20 points – Durability

30 points – Originality, Attractiveness, Creativity, and Neatness

GOLD = 81-100

SILVER = 61-80

BRONZE = up to 60

Awards: Each chapter will receive a certificate
